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Facilities available in college

Guidelines of organize an activity

To organize a cultural activity the guidelines are as follows -

- 1) Setting up a meeting with the cultural committee
- 2) Choosing an appropriate date & time
- 3) Preparation the Guest lists if required
- 4) Sending invitation to the Guests
- 5) Putting up a notice for the trainees and select the participants from them
- 6) Making time table for rehearsal and preparing the groups
- 7) Dividing duties among the faculties and trainees
- 8) Preparing the hall/ venue for the programme and electronics devices for the programme
- 9) Conducting the programme

Procedure of Budget sanction

Budget for cultural programme is prepared only when the related programme has to be done on bigger scale. The budget is prepared in due format and is submitted to the higher authority for approval.
