

## Micro teaching



Micro teaching is a teacher training technique that simplifies the teaching process. It involves teaching a small group of students (5-10) for a short period of time (5-10) minutes to focus on developing specific teaching skills.

Content is divided into smaller units. Only one teaching skill is considered at a time. In micro teaching cycle, there is facility of re-planning, reteaching and re-evaluation.

## Practice teaching



Teaching practice is an important component of becoming a teacher. It grants student teachers experience in the actual teaching and learning environment.

During practice teaching, a student teacher is given the opportunity to try the art of teaching before actually getting into the real world.

Here, teaching is done by a trainee under the supervision of an experienced teacher.
